# What does the Holy Spirit inspire the Biblical writers to say about the Son of God?

- He has always existed (John 1:1-2)
- He is the exact imprint of God's nature (Heb. 1:1-4)
- He is the creator of all things (John 1:3)
- He is life and light (John 1:4-5)
- He was sent because of the love of God (John 1:9-13, Gal. 4:4)
- He is the Word made flesh (John 1:14)

# What does the Father say about the Son of God?

- At Jesus Baptism
  - *“and behold, a voice from heaven said, “This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.” (Matt. 3:17)*
- At the Transfiguration
  - *“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him.” (Matt. 17:5)*

# What does Jesus say about himself?

- I am the bread of life (John 6:35)
- I am the light of the world (John 8:12)
- I am the door of the sheep (John 10:7-9)
- I am the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6-7)
- I am the good shepherd (John 10)
- Before Abraham was, I am (John 8:58)
- I am the resurrection and the life (John 11:25)
