Ephesians 4:4-6

- ▶ “There is one body and one Spirit— just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.”

The Gathered Church in Troas

- ▶ Meeting on the 1st day of the week (Sunday)
- ▶ Paul is departing the next morning
- ▶ Breaking “the bread” (v.11) is Communion
- ▶ Paul preaches and discusses with the church throughout the night

Eutychus Raised

- ▶ “Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? 4 We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. 5 For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.” Romans 6:3-5
